## Year 5 - Term 6 Activities

We have arranged a few special activities for our Year 5 children during Term 6. These events will be funded by the school, however, to honour this, we would require some support with travel in order to avoid coach rental. We hope the children like the sound of what we have planned!

### Howletts Wild Animal Park

On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June years 5 and 6 will be joining Chislet children at Howletts Wild Animal Park for the day. In addition to walking the park there will be a talk on "Climate Change, Habitats and Foraging" which will support our current out learning in class in tandem with the Kent Wildlife Trust.

We would ask that parents drop off the child/children at Howletts for 9.15am and then collect them at 2.30pm. The children should wear a school top but may wear weather appropriate bottoms, they should be in sensible shoes as they will be doing plenty of walking and they should bring with them a sun hat and some sun screen and light jacket should it be required.

They should bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink. Do not give the children any pocket money as there will not be any shopping to be done!

### Space Celebration Day

On Friday 4<sup>th</sup> July, year 5 have been invited to a space celebration day at St Peter's School in Thanet. We will be travelling there and back in the school minibuses. Children will need to wear school uniform and will need to bring a packed lunch and drink with them on the day.

### Victorian Day

On Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July, year 5 and 6 will head to Herne Bay for our Victorian Day. We will be travelling there and back in the school's minibuses. Children will dress as Victorians for the day and will explore Herne Bay as a Victorian. During the day, we will visit the beach, complete a beach clean, head to the Seaside museum (hopefully) and enjoy the park as Victorians did.
