## Year 6 - Term 6 Activities

We would like to send the Year 6 off with some special memories of their time at Hoath Primary School so we have arranged a few special activities for them during Term 6 in addition to the Residential. ### Science Jamboree

Year 6 pupils have also been invited to The Kent Science Festival on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> June at Pfizer Discovery Centre. This afternoon will reinforce the children's' learning of science in school and inspire them with some impressive scientific demonstrations.

The children will be transported by minibus to this event. We will aim to leave school by 12.30pm and will return at 3.30pm; for this reason we ask that all children bring a packed lunch to school on this day as we will be having early lunch.

### Whitemills Aqua Park

On the afternoon of Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June Year 6 children from both Chislet and Hoath will be going to Whitemills Aqua Park in Sandwich. Sadly, the minibuses are in use on this day so we are asking parents to arrange to have their child/children picked up from the school at 1pm to travel to the park. The park will provide the children with wet suits and pizza after they have had fun in the water.

Parents are asked to stay, take photos and enjoy the afternoon with the children heading home once the pizza has been eaten.

### Howletts Wild Animal Park

On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June year 5 and 6 will be joining Chislet children at Howletts Wild Animal Park for the day. In addition to walking the park there will be a talk on "Climate Change, Habitats and Foraging" which will support our current out learning in class in tandem with the Kent Wildlife Trust.

We would ask that parents drop off the child/children at Howletts for 9.15am and then collect them at 2.30pm. The children should wear a school top but may wear weather appropriate bottoms, they should be in sensible shoes as they will be doing plenty of walking and they should bring with them a sun hat and some sun screen and light jacket should it be required.

They should bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink. Do not give the children any pocket money as there will not be any shopping to be done!
