### English:

### Maths:

We have been busy learning how to subitise (correctly identifying the number of a group of objects without the need to count each item) up to 5, and count verbally up to 10. This term we will be focusing on counting to 20, using objects to support us, and learning about shapes with 4 sides.

### Phonics:

The children have been working brilliantly in their Phonic lessons, well done to you all! We have begun learning sounds such as ff, ss, and ai. Phonic story books (paper copies) will be sent home every Friday. These books have been used throughout the week in your child's Phonics lesson. It would be great if your child would like to read this to you 😊

### Other:

Please can you ensure your child has a named coat and wellies in school every day. With the temperature dropping even more please can all children also bring in a named hat and gloves every day, as you know we do a lot of important outside activities.

PE will continue to be every Thursday; PE kits to be worn to school.
