Book Bags

Due to a small cloakroom area, it would be appreciated if the children could bring in a book bag. We also ask that **no toys**, things hanging from bags etc, are brought into school to prevent them from being lost or damaged also due to limited space.

Home Learning

The children will be provided with a homework grid. Each week they will choose **two boxes** to complete, no more or no less. Homework will be sent home on a Friday and will be due back in on a Wednesday. There may be times when an extra piece of English or Maths learning may be sent home but these will be found in their homework folders. If anything extra is sent home, it will be on a Friday and be expected back in on the following Wednesday.

P.E

This term the children will have P.E on a Thursday and Friday. Please make sure that they have full kit:

- Plimsolls/ Trainers
- Coloured T-Shirt
- Black Shorts
- Jogging Bottoms and Jumper

Water Bottles

Please could you make sure that your child is sent in with a named water bottle each day as there are opportunities throughout the day for them to have a drink. If you need a water bottle, they are available to purchase from the office at £1.50. The children should only have water in their bottles please.

Wellies/ Wet Weather

Please could your child bring in a pair of **named** wellies to be left at school. This enables them to use the outdoor area and field even in muddy conditions. Please could you also ensure that they have a waterproof coat so they can still access the field and our outdoor area in all weathers.

Dojo

I will be using the Dojo system, please keep an eye out for any messages as we use this quite frequently. If you need any help with this please come and ask. Also feel free to message any questions or queries, I will reply as soon as I can up until 6pm, weekdays and term time only.
