We have slightly adapted the grid so that each child completes the same homework at the same time. Please complete the grid on a weekly basis, e.g. week one to be completed first. As always, we will collect homework folders on a Wednesday and return the following Friday.

Spellings: please continue to practice these at home. The children will have a quick fire round on a Thursday on these words.

Please continue to hear your child read each day and bring the reading folder into school each day.

We would like your child to read their reading book up to 3 times before we change it. The children will typically be given a new reading book on a Monday and Thursday.

Any child on reading levels 4.1 or above will change their book as soon as they have read them.

Please make sure your child continues to wear their P.E. kit to school on a Tuesday and Friday. Please ensure earrings are removed, if possible.

We understand why a child might want to bring a toy from home in but the expectation is that unless these are linked to a specific SEND need they should not be in school. We appreciate your support and understanding with this.

As the weather will be warming up soon, please can you send your child into school with a hat and sun cream. We cannot apply sun cream to the children, so if they are unable to do this themselves please can you apply it before school.
