Year 6 pupils have been invited to The Kent Science Festival on Thursday 11th June at Pfizer Discovery Centre. This morning will reinforce the children's' learning of science in school and inspire them with some impressive scientific demonstrations.

The children will be transported by minibus to this event. We will aim to leave school by 8.45am and will return at 1.00pm; for this reason we ask that all children bring a packed lunch to school on this day.

Whitemills Aqua Park

On the afternoon of Friday 26th June Year 6 children from both Chislet and Hoath will be going to Whitemills Aqua Park in Sandwich. Sadly, the minibuses are in use on this day so we are asking parents to arrange to have their child/children picked up from the school at 1pm to travel to the park. The park will provide the children with wet suits and pizza or chicken nuggets after they have had fun in the water.

Parents are asked to stay, take photos and enjoy the afternoon with the children if they are able to do so. There is also a café on site for the parents to purchase refreshments if desired. Families may then head home once food has been eaten.

Wingham Wildlife Park

On Tuesday 14th July, Year 5 and 6 will be going to Wingham Wildlife Park for the day. In addition to walking the park, there will be a talk on "African Safari and Australian Species" which will support our current learning in class. We will be using the class gift from the PTA to pay for the talks.

This trip will be funded by school but we would ask that parents drop off their child/children at Wingham for 9.15am and then collect them at 2.30pm.

The children should wear a school top but may wear weather appropriate bottoms, they should be in sensible shoes as they will be doing plenty of walking and they should bring with them a sun hat and some sun screen and light jacket should it be required.

They should bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink. Children can bring a small amount of pocket money to use in the gift shop on the way home. They will be responsible for their own money so please don't give them more than £10 to spend.

Please could you indicate on the permission form if your child has a Wingham pass? If they do, this will save us a few pennies!

Bowling and Cinema Trip

Finally, on Friday 17th July, Year 6 will be visiting Westwood, Thanet. We would ask you to drop your child at Westwood outside Hotel Chocolat for 9.30am. The children will go to the Hollywood Bowl for a game of bowling and then some lunch.

From the bowling, we then plan to take the children to the Vue cinema to see a film. Due to the scheduling at the cinema we are unable to currently name the film we will be seeing, however Toy Story 5 and the new Despicable Me film are most likely. Timings have also not yet been released so we will send more information regarding this trip closer to the time. Please note that we will be asking for a donation of £10 towards the cost of this trip.

The children should wear a school top but trousers, shorts or skirts bottoms are all permitted. The children will be allowed to take in a snack and small drink into the cinema with them.
